All prospective bidders should attend the opening of bids meeting on Tuesday, February 28, 2023 in the Southwestern Elementary Board Room at 5:00 p.m. at the regular School Board meeting.

All bidders must furnish, as bid surety, a personal bond, cash, or check payable to Southwestern Jefferson County Consolidated School Corporation in the amount of two hundred dollars (\$200.00). All surety shall be returned as per bid specifications. A fully executed non-collusion affidavit and additional materials shall accompany each bid. Route descriptions and specifications, which describe the routes to be traveled, the equipment to be furnished, and all other conditions required in the contract are available at the central office at the above address.

The Board of School Trustees of Southwestern Jefferson County Consolidated School Corporation reserves the right to reject any and all bids (IC 20-27-5-10), to waive any information or irregularities, and to make any necessary changes or alterations in the original route description. A minimum of one route will be awarded to any one contract driver. Each contract driver must be a proposed school bus driver and registered owner. The contract driver is advised that the Board of School Trustees reserves the right to award the routes or to assign the route(s) to the Corporation pool. The age and condition of the equipment will be considered a factor in route awards. The Board reserves the right to negotiate or make an offer, as they deem appropriate prior to the beginning of a new contract.
